Supervision of research studies at the undergraduate and graduate levels has provided currency in research and analysis. The creation of off-site cohort groups has caused graduate programs to expand and meet the needs of underserved groups.
- Numerous presentations and workshops for educators, locally, and nationally have provided excellent opportunities to keep abreast of the issues and concerns of higher education and a platform to develop strategies for addressing those concerns.
- Involvement with governmental organizations and learned societies in developing education models that incorporate a competency-based curriculum. This has provided an excellent framework for understanding the various factors impeding change in the educational process, as well as strategies for overcoming those obstacles.
